

# CSI Pioneer Open

## Dec 2-4, 2011

**Sanction:** This is a Colorado Swimming event, hosted by Univ of Denver Hilltoppers. Held under the sanction of USA Swimming Sanction # 2011-018. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

**Location:** University of Denver, Coors Fitness Center, I-25 and University Blvd, 2201 E. Asbury, Denver, CO 80208  
Elevation 5342 ft.

**Parking:** From I-25: University exit south from I-25, and make your first turn east onto Buchtel Blvd. Parking will be available on the north side of Buchtel Blvd. Parking lot is named 108. **Map & Permit included. Participants must have permit in dashboard.**

**Eligibility:** USA member athletes holding a 2011-2012 current registration. Swimmers within the 120 day transfer period must swim unattached. Age as of the first day of competition will determine a swimmer's age group. If a swimmer attends the meet without his/her coach, the athlete must notify the meet referee immediately upon arrival at the meet. No deck registrations will be allowed.

**Facility:** Dependent upon number of entrants, Competition water depth measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3 ranges below. The host team reserves the right to run prelims and/or timed final sessions in one or two competition courses:

- In one 10 lane, 25 yard course, 7 ft on start end, and from 6 to 13 ft on turn end.
- Two competition courses:
  - Course A= 8 lane, 25 yard, from 7 to 9 ft on start end, and 7 ft on turn end.
  - Course B= 5, 6 or 7 lane 25 yard, from 5 to 7 ft on start end, and 5 to 7 ft on turn end.
- Continuous warm-up/down lanes will be available in all circumstances.

**Finals:** Will consist of top sixteen for 12 & Under events, top sixteen for 14 & Under, top twenty-four for Open events with the following exceptions: 1)Finals for the 500 yd Free, and 400 IM will consist of top eight for 12 & Under and 14 & Under, and top sixteen for Open. Points will be awarded for places 9 through 16 in prelims in events where only 8 swimmers will compete in finals.

**Qualification Times:** Will be strictly enforced. Times must have been achieved since Dec 1, 2010. Any entry with NT (no time) or entries with times slower than the qualification time will be rejected with no refunds. NOTE: Submit entry times according to the time swum NO CONVERSIONS. Non-Conforming entry times will be seeded last. **Timed Finals Session must include entry times, NT entries are not acceptable, and will be rejected.** TOPS Swimmers will be exempt from the 10 & Under Timed Final Qualification times.

### **Entry Limit:**

Prelim/Final: Maximum 3 individual events and 1 relay per day, 7 individual event limit for the meet.

Timed Final: Maximum 4 Individual events and 1 relay per day, 8 individual event limit for the meet.

## ***Schedule:***

Prelims/Finals for 12&U, 14&U, and OPEN age groups.

Timed Final for 10 & Unders.

Preliminaries: General Warm-up: 7 – 8:00 am, Specific Warm-up: 8:00 - 8:20 a.m. Meet Start: 8:30 a.m.

***Timers:*** Each participating team will be assigned timing assignments corresponding to the number of entrants.

***CSI Senior Circuit:*** Events swum will count toward CSI Senior Circuit event total. Athletes who compete in 9 events or more Senior Circuit Events will be eligible for an extra .5 share of funding per CSI re-imbusement procedures.

***Rules:*** Current USA rules will govern the procedures of this meet.

1. The MEET REFEREE will have the final authority on all conduct of the meet.
2. The USA Swimming National Start will be used. This meet will enforce timely reporting to the block area and responding promptly to signals and commands as follows: When the swimmers and officials are ready, the Referee shall signal with an out stretched arm to the starter that the swimmers are under the Starter control. Swimmers stepping up late after the Referee has signaled with an outstretch arm releasing the field to the Starter “may,” at the discretion of the referee, be barred from competing in that event. It is the responsibility of every swimmer and coach to ensure that they report to the starting area in a timely fashion and respond to all signals and commands of the meet officials promptly. (Rule # 101.1.5B)
3. Events 31-32 Open 1650 Free, Events 59-62 the 400 IM , and 95-100 the 500 Free
  - Depending on number of entrants, these events may be deck seeded. If deck seeded they require positive check-in with the clerk of course.
  - If an athlete does not positive check-in they may not be allowed to compete.
  - Will require you to provide your own timers and counters. 1650 Free will be swum fastest to slowest heats alternating girls and boys.
  - Events 59-62, 95-100 may be swum top 3 seeded heats of each event first in prelims, and then the remainder of the seeded heats.
4. No exhibition swimming will be allowed.
5. Unattached/Unaccompanied swimmers -
  - Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
  - Unattached/Unaccompanied swimmers must be assigned to a coach from another team to act in their interest during the meet.. Assigned coach shall be responsible for supervision of warm-up/warm-down, and all other responsibilities of the swimmer. Report to the Meet Ref. for assignment of a coach.
6. The use of cell phones or any cameras are prohibited in the locker rooms. On deck changing is not allowed.

**Awards:** Awards and points will only be earned for the event swum, i.e., a 12 year old swimming an Open event will be ranked and scored in that event as Open – not as 12&U.

Prelim/Final Session: Awards will be given for 12&U, 14&U and Open events, regardless of age.

### ***Seeding Procedure & Scratch Rules:***

National scratch procedures will be enforced as per 207.12.6 in the USA Rules and Regulations.

- Scratches for Friday's events must be submitted by 2pm on Thursday. Scratches must be submitted by e-mail to [meetentries@msn.com](mailto:meetentries@msn.com)
- Scratch box for Saturday and Sunday's events will close 30 min after the start of finals the evening prior.
- EXCEPTION: Any swimmer not reporting for or failing to compete in a 10 & under individual timed final event shall not be penalized.

**Entry Procedures:** All Meet entries should be submitted via e-mail using Hy-Tek software. Please include the following attachments: 1) TM Export Entry file, 2) TM Individual Entry Report, 3) TM Relay Entry Report and 4) TM Entry Fee Report. Master Sheets must be provided if unable to present entries using Hy-Tek.

**Entry Deadline:** Meet entries must be received via e-mail by the Entry Chairman no later than **Monday Nov 21, 2011 at 6pm**. Hard Copies and Entry Fees must be postmarked by Tuesday Nov 22. Entries received after these dates will be accepted at the meet director's discretion.

- Late entries may be accepted during the meet will be charged \$7.50 per event and seeded only in open lanes if available. Late entries must be prepared to show proof of time and proof of registration.

**Psych Sheets and Final Warm-up Meet Start times** will be posted at [www.recreation.du.edu/hilltoppers](http://www.recreation.du.edu/hilltoppers) by Monday Nov 28<sup>th</sup>.

**Refreshments:** Food must be eaten in the Concourse Area. No refreshments are allowed in the pool area, regardless of their source.... University of Denver policy.

**Seating:** NO parent seating or standing on the pool deck. Athletes will be allowed to sit on the pool deck. If you need to get your child to and from an event, this is 100% acceptable. To allow our parents a viewing area, there will be NO permanent seating in the pool bleachers. There will be additional seating in the concourse and adjacent gymnasium.

**Restrictions:** Smoking or the use of other tobacco products is prohibited inside DU. Lawn/Deck chairs are only permissible in designated areas.

**Warm-up Procedures:** CSI warm-up procedures will be followed. Each coach will be responsible for the monitoring of their swimmers during warm-up. Specific Warm-up will be conducted for the last 15 minutes of each warm-up session. Swimmers must enter the pool feet first except during coach-supervised starts.

**Coaches/Officials:** All coaches and uniformed officials must display their USA/CSI cards when on deck. Current certification is mandatory. Coaches and officials that are in non-compliance will not be allowed on deck. ***There will be a mandatory coaches meeting Friday December 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30am.***

- This will be a National Certification Meet. A mandatory officials meeting will be held at the START of warm-up for Prelims & Finals, each day of the meet. A minimum of 4 sessions must be worked during the prelim/final portion of the meet to apply for national certification. The Meet Referee will have the final authority on all swimming procedures of the meet. In addition, at the Referee's discretion, individual events may be combined by age, sex, and or distance.
- This will be an Officials Qualify Meet for those officials wishing to be evaluated for N2 and N3 certification. N2 evaluations will be offered for all positions: Stroke & Turn, Starter, Chief Judge and Deck Referee. N3 evaluations will be offered for Stroke and Turn additionally, N3 Initial evaluations will be offered for: Chief Judge and Deck Referee. Officials wishing to be evaluated must submitted an Application to Officiate, to Kathleen Morris [kamorris@psdschools.org](mailto:kamorris@psdschools.org) and or Mike Dilli [mdilli@q.com](mailto:mdilli@q.com) no later than November 21, 2011 for assigned positions, and November 25, 2011 for non-assigned positions. Applications can be found on the [coloradoswimming.org](http://coloradoswimming.org) website / officials / applications.
- A mandatory Officials meeting will be held at the START of warm-up for each session, each day of the meet. No trainees will be allowed on deck for the prelim/final portion of this meet. Trainees will be allowed during timed final sessions.
